

Testimony Notes

Thank you for being willing to stand up and give your testimony. Remember, giving your testimony is not a competition or an opportunity to show off our old man. It is intended to be an encouragement for others to hear about how the Lord Jesus Christ has affected you. It is not about you, but the story of you in Christ.

Here are some questions that can guide you through a brief 10-15 minute talk.

1. **How did you first hear/trust the gospel?** If you were involved with church or identified with Christianity before you trusted the gospel, please explain. There are many unsaved church-goers that can sympathize with your story. Be sure to explain how you know you are saved now.
2. How did you first hear/learn mid-Acts Pauline right division?
3. How has knowing Jesus Christ according to the revelation of the mystery affected your life?
4. How has God's word helped you through any struggles/difficult questions/life choices?
5. Where are you at now? In what area are you continuing to grow? How? What is your part in ministry for the Lord?

The only right answers to these questions are honest ones.
